- **ACADEMICS:** In the area of teaching and learning, there is noticeable improvement in the cumulative performance of students. Some classes did not record any failure. We have identified the few students with special learning difficulties and arrangements have been put in motion to tackle this challenge.
- **EXTERNAL EXAMS:** We are happy to announce that the WAEC, JSC and NECO exams have all been concluded by our students and we are hopeful they will make us proud with excellent results.
- **EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** In spite of the short span of the term, the school managed to organize inter-class football competition between the SSS 2 and SSS 1 girls.
