## NEWS LETTER

**Dear esteemed parents,**

Compliments of the season. It is with great joy that we return to you briefly the children you gave to us. It is important they are with you this period to share in the love that goes with the season.

In the tradition of Calvary International Schools, Orji, we hereby relay to you the events, programmes, academic and extra-academic activities that made the term worthwhile.

**P.T.A MEETING:** It is heartwarming to know that the PTA fire has been rekindled. We now have a vibrant PTA: In the first meeting after its inauguration, the PTA unanimously agreed on a modest PTA levy of ₦ 2000 per term.

### **EXTRA-CURRICULA EVENTS:**

**Singing Competition:** We had the maiden edition of the Chinaza Ihebom singing competition between the boarding and day students in which the day students defeated the boarders. Chinaza Ihebom is an ex-student of Calvary International Schools.

**INTER-HOUSE COOKING COMPETITION:** The four traditional Houses of Calvary International Schools engaged in a robust cooking competition. While the judges acknowledged that they were all great cooks, the Yellow House was declared the winner of the contest.

**INTER-SCHOOL FOOTBALL FRIENDLY:** We had a friendly football match with the governor's school (Rochas Foundation College) in which we defeated Rochas' Foundation College.

**SEND OFF:** A send off ceremony was organized by the school for Mr. Nwaobia, the former Vice Principal. The students spiced the event with dances and drama.

### **SKILL ACQUISITION:**

- The school engaged some experts to come to teach students how to produce disinfectants, liquid soap and air fresher; most of our students can now produce those things by themselves.
- The food and nutrition students of SSS 2 also demonstrated their knowledge and dexterity in the baking of different types of cakes.

**NECO ACCREDITATION:** We have successfully been re-accredited by NECO after scoring above 80% in their assessment for accreditation. SSS 3 students can now register for NECO on resumption in January.

**WAEC & NECO REGISTRATIONS:** Registration for WAEC & NECO has commenced for SSS 3 students. The total fee for WAEC registration is ₦ 28000 the breakdown is as follows:

- Official Reg. fee = ₦ 18000
- WAEC Practical = ₦ 2000
- Extra Mural = ₦2000
- Mock Exam = ₦ 1000
- Ministry of Ed. = ₦2000
- Off line Reg. = ₦ 1500
- Invigilation = ₦ 1500      —————> Total = ₦ 28000

**NECO Registration fee is ₦ 26000.**

The total registration fee for both **WAEC & NECO** therefore is **₦ 54000**

**BEST PERFORMACE:** The best performing student for the term is **ONYEMAUCHE FAVOUR** of **JSS 3** class, who made an overall best average score of **92.4**. In normal Calvary tradition, the student is entitled to a free tuition next term.

**RESUMPTION:** The 2<sup>nd</sup> term of 2018/19 academic session will begin on Monday. 14 January, 2019. The boarding students are expected to be back before 6pm on Sunday, 13 January, 2019.

- ✓ **SECOND TERM OUTING:** Parents should be reminded that we shall as usual take the students on excursion to any educationally interesting site approved by the school by the second week after mid-term break. Students shall pay an excursion fee of ₦ 3000 each.

### **BOARDING LIFE APPRAISAL**

It is a thing of elation that we have come to the end of the term. But the term did not end without our keen observation and utter reservation to the flouting of some boarding rules by parents and boarders alike. While we are fully committed to training our students to become self-reliant in every facet of life, parents must also see themselves as stakeholders in the overall affairs of the students. Therefore, we wish to reiterate some of the boarding rules and regulations relating to parents:

### **HOSTEL RULES**

1. Parents should endeavor to bring their children back to school with the required fees in order to help the school to buy required food items for the boarders as we cannot go to market empty handed.
2. Visiting days are usually first Saturdays of every month. Except in health-related cases otherwise no parent will be allowed to visit their ward on non visiting days.
3. Visitors and non-boarders are prohibited from the hostels, except with due clearance from the authorities
4. Phones and other electronic gadgets are prohibited in the Hostel.

5. Destruction of hostel property is a serious offence and parents will be contacted for reparation in case of malicious damage.
6. Day wears should be clean and complete. Buttons should be fixed and amendment done where necessary and any student without the complete set of wears on resumption shall be sent home.
7. Wrong hairdo is not allowed for both boys and girls.
8. . White gown for girls and shirt and trousers for boys is compulsory for Sunday worship.

## **REFECTORY RULES**

1. Boarders must be provided with cutlery. Boarders are prohibited from sharing their eating materials.
2. Visitors and non-boarders are prohibited from the refectory area. **Most importantly,** every boarder must be provided with a torchlight.

We are very much delighted to inform you that the term was a very fruitful one as there are noticeable improvements in the overall academic performance of students. We strongly believe that with your understanding and the right things done, our efforts will greatly be complemented. We hope to see all the regulatory issues raised in this piece addressed by next term.
